Whitland Dairy Sale

Whitland Dairy sales got up and running with a bang respectable entry of 41 head and good crowd of onlookers and keen buyers who set a good trade for all categories. Freshly calved cows sold to £1720 for Willhome Golden Dawn from Jones, Pistyllgwyn while four nice second calf Jersey Cows from the Nicel Herd of Evans, Nantyci sold for an average of £952. The heifer section saw animals of the highest quality and the standard was set with the first heifer in, from Evans, Derimoelion, Deri Daisy May that joined the Gatrog Herd for £1880. The Deri herd topped the day, twice exceeding the £2000 mark with £2150 for Deri Madeline (pictured below) also to Gatrog Holsteins and £2050 for Deri Bless who went to Thomas, Gwarllwyn, Whitland. Other leading prices were £1900 for Deri Anita and £1820 for a super commercial heifer from Lewis, Fronun who also sold a smart Shorthorn heifer for £1450. A consignment of cows and heifers, calved from November to February, from Myrtle Farms Ltd, Llanboidy, saw his cows sell to £1200 and average £890 while his heifers sold to £1620 averaging £960. The demand was strong and overall it was an excellent first sale.
