

CRYMYCH MART REPORT WEDNESDAY 7TH JUNE 2017

With just over 700 head entered the majority being cull sheep prices peaked at £128 for a crossbred ram from Davies, Ynys Fawr. A few pens of new season store lambs were entered and prices reached £81 for Charollais X ram lambs from Fitchett, Nantyweirglodd. The next mart will be held on Wednesday 21st June.

CULL SHEEP (538):

It was the ram section that dominated the top and leading prices at £128 from Davies, Ynys Fawr; whilst the best ewes sold to £86 from Jenkins, Tyhen. Cull ewes averaged £53/head. Top and leading prices as follows:

STORE HOGGET'S (114):
