

CRYMYCH MART REPORT WEDNESDAY 21st JUNE 2017

An entry of 676 head, mainly cull ewes which topped the trading at £97/head for Suffolk Mules from Leany, Cruglas. The number of store lambs is ever increasing and prices reached £84.50 for quality continental types from Llewelin, High Toch.
