

## Whitland Dairy Market Report – Friday 07/07/2017

### Dairy (248) 10.30am

Whitland dairy showed on Friday that there is still an excellent option in South Wales to sell dairy animals and that travelling your animals hundreds of miles to find a market is not the only other option. It also showed that the live auction is without doubt the best way to go. With 55 different purchasers on the day and even more bidders that left empty handed the first class herd presented by Adrian Rees, Rhos had something for everyone and quality right through from Lot 1 to the last lot.

Top price of the day was £1900 for an April calved, Jersey cross, 2<sup>nd</sup> calver giving 36kg of milk daily. The top thirty animals sold over £1500 with seventeen of those getting over £1700. Dry cows were also in good demand getting to a high of £1650 and regularly over the £1200 mark.

The sale finished off with 30 quality in calf Friesian heifers that topped at £1450 and averaged £993.
