Peaking at £90.50 was a ewe from Webb, Cefn; other leading prices at £88.50 for a ewe from Parry, Lochland who also sold at £79.50; £83.50 for a ewe from George, Penwernddu who also sold at £81.50; £81.50 for ewes from Webster Farms, Nantyrefail; £77.50 for ewes from Picton, Tymawr; £72 for a ewe from Evans & Co, Pantirion; £70.50 for ewes from Lewis & Son, Cilgwyn Mawr who also sold at £68.50. The best rams sold to £71 from James, Llethr.

CALVES (30):

A small entry sold to a solid trade which saw the best beef bulls reaching £340 for a Charolais from Parry, Croesgwyn who also sold another Charolais bull at £330 and a Charolais heifer at £280; other leading prices at £330 for a BB bull from Davies, Wallaston Farm; £290 for a BB bull from Shepherd, Garnwen who also sold a BB heifer at £222; £275 for a BB bull from Reed, Rhosygadair. The best black and white rearing calves topped at £156 for a Friesian from Jones & Co, Trewenfron who also sold others at £138, £130; £94 for a H/Fr from Williams & Son, Trehenry.
