STORE CATTLE & GRAZING COWS (20):

A 21m Welsh Black steer from Humphreys, Esgyr Draw peaked at £1045, the same vendor also sold a 19m Welsh Black bull at £820; £810 for a pair of 24m Friesian steers from George & Son, Goitre Farm; £795 for an 18m Hereford heifer from Thomas, Cwmglyne who also sold a 15m Hereford steer at £785.

Grazing bulls topped at £1230 for a 1100k bull from Boak, Bronwenallt; other leading prices at £1080 for a 720k Lim cow from Evans & Co, Pantirion; £940 for a 720k H/Fr cow from Lewis, Morfa who also sold a 635k H/Fr at £920 and a 580k H/Fr at £770.
