

## CARDIGAN MART REPORT MONDAY 14<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2017

### PRIME LAMBS (524):

A much improved entry was seen this week and the lamb trade certainly did not disappoint, the best were well over 195p peaking at 202p for the best meated types from Howells, 5 Kensington Street. Heavyweight lambs from Evans, Blaenffynnon topped at £95/head, which saw the overall market average level at 193p/kg, top and leading prices as follows:
