STORE LAMBS (44):

Topping at £57.50 were 36.5k lambs from Davies, Blaenwaun; £54.50 for 42.5k lambs from Harries, Little Holgan.

CULL SHEEP (36):

A small entry sold to £95 for a ram from Howells, 5 Kensington Street who also sold ewes at £68 and £67; other leading prices at £68 for a ram from Lewis & Son, Cilgwyn Mawr; £66.50 for ewes from Morgan, Pencefn who also sold at £61.50 and £60.

CALVES (45):

Reaching £272 was a BB heifer from Trebared Cyf, Fferm Trebared; other leading prices at £208 for a Hereford bull from Thomas, Glandwr Ceibwr who also sold another Hereford bull at £202 and a Hereford heifer at £185; £192 for an AA bull from Parkes, Pengaer; £182 for a Hereford bull from Scourfield, Parc-Y-Pwll. The best rearing black and white calves sold to £66 from Griffiths, Aberbrwynen Farm.

STORE CATTLE & GRAZING COWS (73):

The majority of store cattle forward were dairy bred, but a 17m Hereford steer sold at £880 from James, Glynmaen who also sold a pair of 17m Hereford steers at £840; £790 for a 18m Lim heifer from Thomas, Dolau Newydd who also sold a 15m Lim heifer at £740; £780 for a 26m H/Fr from Morris, Tyriet.

An improved entry of grazing cows topped at £1070 for an 815k BB from Lewis & Son, Tyriet who also sold a 645k AA at £1040, £970 for a 780k Lim, £950 for a 770k Lim, £930 for an 810k Lim, £920 for a 685k Lim. The tested cows reached £805 for a 740k Hereford from James, Glynmaen.
