

MARKET REPORT FOR WHITLAND LIVESTOCK MARKET FOR
SATURDAY 7th OCTOBER 2017

Following the store cattle sale on Saturday 7th October was the annual club sale for the South Wales Limousin Breeders, which this year had a very special sentiment to it as it included the dispersal of the Orllwyn herd for JJ Morris Auctioneer, Gareth Thomas and Family. The Orllwyn herd was in it's 25th year and had been successful in shows, both local and national, and herd competitions throughout its time.



Never afraid to invest in the herd there was always well bought stockbulls present at Orllwyn, often purchased at sale topping prices and often resold at sale topping prices also.

The most recent bull, Ashledge Judaspriest, the Senior and Supreme Champion at Brecon when first purchased was still a popular lot on the day of the dispersal, selling at 3100gns and joining D & I Jones, Brynspeard, Dorstone, Hereford.

The Orllwyn females were in excellent condition and the interest and support from both local buyers and ones that had travelled made for a very strong trade. Top price cow and calf was 2700gns for Orllwyn Felicity with her May born heifer calf Orllwyn Niceaspie (by Judaspriest). However a combined top of 3800gns was achieved by Orllwyn Iphone and her registered bull calf, Orllwyn Nimrod born in January and sold separately at 2050gns and 1750gns respectively. Incalf heifers sold to 1880gns for Orllwyn Ladyluck a Sherry Fighter daughter scanned incalf to the Ashledge bull. The maiden heifers topped at 2300gns with Orllwyn Molly by Sherry Fighter.
