### **STORE CATTLE & GRAZING COWS:**

The best cows topped at £1150 for a 795k Charolais from Vaughan & Sons, Fagwrgoch who also sold a 770k Simmental at £990 and a 720k Hereford at £980. Store cattle reached £1020 for a 25m Charolais heifer from Davies, Hendre; £1000 for a 24m Lim heifer from Hugl, Hendre who also sold a 24m BB steer at £920.

### **CALVES (69):**

Topping at £370 was an AA bull from Davies, Wallaston Farm who also sold an AA heifer at £300, £230 and £190; £292 for a BB bull from Lloyd, Tegfan who also sold a Lim bull at £242 and a BB bull at £232; £290 for a BB heifer from Davies Cyf, Canllefaes Uchaf; £232 for a Hereford bull from Sollis, Ffynnonddofn who also sold another Hereford bull at £228; £228 for a BB bull from Reed, Rhosygadair Fawr. The best black and white rearing bulls peaked at £150 for a H/Fr from Richards, Llain; £116 for a H/Fr from Sollis, Ffynnonddofn; £115 for a Friesian from Davies, Wallaston Farm.
