

CARDIGAN MART REPORT MONDAY 4TH JUNE 2018

SPRING LAMBS (116):

The supply of lambs remains very selective, trade had definitely risen within the week reaching a top price of £111 for good continental types from Sacco, Parcyneithw. A maximum pence per kilo of 246p was achieved for standard weight lambs from Raymond, Longhouse Farm. The overall average was at 229p/kg, top and leading prices as follows:

HOGGET'S (82):

Prices now reflective of the limited demand as most supermarkets have now swapped to spring lambs, a top price of £81 was achieved for a 55k hog from James, Bryngolau; £74 for 54 kilos from Linfoot, Bigni; £70 for 60k from Lewis, Parcyreithin who also sold 44 kilos at the same money.

CULL EWES (147):

A good entry of quality ewes peaked at £108 for a ewe from Davies, Alltgoch who also sold ewes at £100; £97 for a ewe from Davies, Blaenweirglodd who also sold ewes at £94.50; £95.50 for ewes from Davies, Pant-Y-Gelli who also sold other ewes at £94.50, £87 and £84.50; £83 for a ram from Raymond, Longhouse Farm; £84 for ewes from Thomas, Gilwen; £83 for ewes from Wells, Glaneri.

BARREN COWS & STORE CATTLE:

The best meated cows topped at £900 for an 860k Fr from Williams, Ffrwdwenith who also sold a 720k Friesian at £725; £710 for a 700k Fr from Thomas, Glandwr Ceibwr. A small entry of stores reached £610 for young H/Fr steers from Davies, Crugcoy.

CALVES (16):

A small entry of calves reached £160 for a Hereford heifer from Thomas, Cilau Farm; £150 for a Hereford bull from Sollis, Ffynnonddofn. The best black and white dairy bulls reached £94 for a Friesian from Jenkins & Rees Cyf, Trefere Fawr; £64 for a H/Fr from Davies, Brynhyfryd.
