CULL SHEEP (234):

The selective trade continues, nevertheless the best ewes reached £92 from Rees Bros, Penanty, with the overall average at £30/head. Looking back to this time last year a top price of £94 was seen with an average of £31. Top and leading prices as follows:

BREEDING EWES (436):

Yearlings from Morgan, Bwlchclawdd peaked at £92, the same vendor also sold yearlings at £86, £85, £81 and £78. More ewe lambs were on offer which peaked at £78 for White faced Mules from Rees Bros, Penanty who also sold others at £70.

BREEDING RAMS (57):

An improved entry of rams peaked at £340 for a 3 year old Charollais from Rees Bros, Penanty; other leading prices at £320 for a pair of Texel yearlings from Marlsborough Farm Ltd, Marlsborough who also sold other Texel yearlings at £300; £310 for a yearling Texel from Scurlock & Sons, Solbury who also sold another yearling Texel at £280; £280 for a Texel yearling from James Brothers Ltd, Sunny Hill.

STORE LAMBS (517):

The number of store lambs remains quite constant with no sudden influx, this time last year there was an entry of over 1200. The best continental types reached £65 from James Brother Ltd, Sunny Hill with the overall average at £44/head, top and leading prices as follows:
