

## CARDIGAN MART REPORT MONDAY 5<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2018

### FAT LAMBS (154):

A small entry was seen, with more lambs definitely needed. Reaching a top of 171p/kg were 43kg lambs from R.I. James, Newton East. 50kg lambs from the same vendor topped the Fat section at £80.80 per head. The overall average for the section was at 158.93p/kg, top and leading prices as follows:

### STORE LAMBS (30):

An entry of 30 store lambs topped at £61/head from DJ & DA Phillips, Trellwyn Fawr which sold at 154p/kg. Two other pens from the same vendor also sold at a decent £59.50/head for 39.50k and £57.00/head for 39k.

### CULL SHEEP (13):

Cull sheep peaked at £72/head, from WL & PA Williams, Gotrel, with an average for the section of £59.56.

### CALVES (67):

With an entry of 48 bull calves and 19 heifer calves, the section was topped with a price of £260 for two Aberdeen Angus heifer calves from WJC & IJ Lewis & Son, Cilgwyn Mawr with other leading prices including £250 for a British Blue bull calf from Messrs Fordham, Dolgoch and £210 for a Simmental bull calf from K & JFM Edwards, Pallau. Strong Hereford bull calves also did well, with three selling from MJE & EB Jones, Rhydygofaint at £182, £162 & £140; with another Hereford bull calf from WJC & IJ Lewis & Son, Cilgwyn Mawr selling at £165. The best black and white bull calves sold for £98 & £90 from DH & SE Thomas, Gwarllwyn.

### STORE CATTLE (17):

With a small entry of store cattle, the top beef lot was a pen of two 26 month old fresian steers from M & SK Murphy, Vaynor Farm; which sold for £775/head. A 24 month old Hereford steer from the same vendor was also sold at £650. The top lot of store heifers was from GM Webb, Cefn, which comprised a pen of four 8 month old Charolais heifers, which sold at £500/head. Grazing Cows peaked at £720 for 730k Blonde from Boak, Brownen-Allt.

### COWS & CALVES:

An entry of two cows and calves was topped with the price of £740 for a Simmental unit from A Colledge, Gwarmacwydd.
