

## CARDIGAN MART REPORT MONDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2018

### FAT LAMBS (122):

A small entry was seen, with more lambs definitely needed. Reaching a top of 173p/kg were 45kg lambs from D Morris, Pencwarre. 54kg lambs from J Drage, Penfai Farm topped the Fat section at £81.00 per head. The overall average for the section was at 161.35p/kg, top and leading prices as follows:

### STORE LAMBS (47):

A slightly larger entry of entry of 47 store lambs topped at £65/head from AH & M Raymond, Longhouse Farm, which sold at 144p/kg. WJC & IJ Lewis & Son, Cilgwin Mawr achieved £59 for 40k's and JT Davies & Co, Tygwyn £57 for 40.5k lambs.

The highest p/kg was achieved by a pen of 34k lambs, from SR & KP Turner, Ty Riet which sold at 166p/kg, closely followed by 28.5kg lambs selling at 165p/kg.

### CALVES (112):

With a decent entry of 94 bull calves and 18 heifer calves, the calf shed was saw some keen buyers and strong entries. The section was topped with a price of £295 British Blue bull calf from T Evans, Troedryaur, with the average for bull calves sitting at £62.69 and heifers at £81.

Other bull calves that broke the £200 barrier include two other British Blue entries from T Evans, Troedryaur which sold at £275 and £240; a British Blue from TGJ & NV George, Mount Farm at £228 and a Hereford from WJC & IJ Lewis & Son, Cilgwyn at £218.

The best black and white bull calves sold for £72 for a Fresian from RG & RA Jones & Sons, Robleston Hall & £70 for a Holstein Fresian from Emerald Grove Farms Ltd, Gelliorlas.

Heifer calves topped at £185 for a British Blue from RG & RA Jones & Sons, Robleston Hall, followed by a £154 Hereford from WJC & IJ Lewis & Son, Cilgwyn Mawr and a Simmental for £145 from K & JFM Edwards, Pillau.
