STORE HOGGETS (19):

In a smaller entry of store hoggets, the section was topped with £76.50 from JD & PJ Rees, Fern House for a pen of four animals, followed by £74 for a single hogget from TV & JM Salmon, Trepant. The section averaged at £61 and 163p.

CALVES (83):

A decent entry to see the new year in saw 58 bull calves and 25 heifer calves entered.

The section was topped with the price of £300 for a three month old Limousin Bull Calf from Rees Bro's Penenanty, followed by £212 for a one month old British Blue Bull Calf from SPR Reed, Rhosygadiar. This was followed by £240 for a month old Hereford Bull Calf from WJC & IJ Lewis & Son, Cilgwyn Mawr. The best black and white bull calves sold well at £95 for a Fresian from AH Picton, Tymawr followed by £82 for another Friesian from the same vendor. Heifer calves topped at £205 for a British Blue from MJE & EB Jones, Rhydygofaint, followed by £190 for a Hereford calf from TE & MRL Jones, Pantyrhendy. The average for bull calves sat at a healthy £88.45 which is up on last year and heifers averaged at £106.84 which is also up on the last mart.

CULL SHEEP & TUPS (65 & 6):

Cull sheep peaked at £95 for a single heavy ewe from GR Webb, Cefn, with the average for the section at £56.38. Cull Rams peaked at £81 from DLS & P Richards, Haysford Park.

GRAZING COWS (13):

A single grazing cow was entered from DP & HM George & Son, Goitre Farm, which sold for £370.
