Top price of the day was Sylio Stratify Enid 2 from Hefin Davies Ltd at £1820 that joined the Carwyn Herd in New Moat. A wonderful consignment from the Sylio herd set a very good pace, also selling at £1780 for Sylio Johnson Wonder, £1720 for Sylio Calber Enid 2 and Sylio Entrust Vera 3 and £1700 for Sylio Roble Strawberry. Also at £1700 was a super milky cow from Jones, Oswestry and two very smart heifers from the Castellhyfryd herd.

Incalf heifers sold to a top of £1220 while a group of 24 September born heifer calves met a very strong trade reaching highs of £480 and averaging £438 throughout.
